

ACT 1415-SU-005

An Act Concerning the Options of National Representation for the Council of Graduate Students

Section 1. The purpose of this act shall be to amend the Constitution of The Council of Graduate Students (CGS) to remove from the stipulation that CGS be a member of the National Association of Graduate and Professional Students, and give the Council more freedom to pursue the most effective means of national representation for Ohio State graduate students.

Section 2. Whereas, Article II, Section II.4 of the Constitution of the CGS currently reads as follows:

“The Council shall represent The Ohio State University graduate student body in the National Association of Graduate-Professional Students.”


Section 3. Whereas, in order to broaden the options available to the Council, the amended section will read as:

“Section II.4, The Council shall represent The Ohio State University graduate student body at the national level in a manner as determined by the Executive Committee in consultation with the Delegate Body. The President or his/her designee will be the primary representative of the Council at the national level and shall keep the Council informed of all such activities.

Section 5. Therefore, be it resolved that this act gives more freedom of the Council to pursue the most effective means of national representation

Section 6. Further, be it resolved, the changes contained within this act, shall be effective immediately and the Constitution will be updated to reflect such a change.
