RESOLUTION 2021-002 1 A RESOLUTION CALLING UPON THE UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO THE 2020 ELECTION EARLY VOTE AT THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS 3 4 5 Authors: Madeleine Lomax-Vogt(.2), Government Affairs Chair; Brandon Free(.41), Delegate, Material 6 Science & Welding Engineering 7 Sponsors: Government Affairs Committee 8 9 WHEREAS, the Council of Graduate Students is vested with authority to voice graduate student concerns and 10 needs to the University; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the fundamental values and goals of The Ohio State University embrace the mission of preparing a 13 diverse student body to be leaders and engaged citizens¹; and 14 15 WHEREAS, voting is a critical civic duty that impacts the well-being of individuals and our community by 16 helping us realize the ideals of a vibrant democracy; and 17 18 WHEREAS, only 41 percent of The Ohio State University graduate students voted in the 2018 election²; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has exacerbated the challenges that students who do not drive or do not 21 have access to a vehicle face when attempting to vote early or on election day in-person; and 22 23 WHEREAS, robust access to early voting reduces the congregate density, waiting times, and demands on 24 polling stations on Election Day; and 25 26 WHEREAS, in-person early voting for the 2020 Election lasts from October 6, 2020 to November 2, 2020; and 27 28 WHEREAS, The Ohio State University and OSU Votes provided transportation to the Franklin County Board of Elections during the 2018 Election early vote^{3,4}; and 30 partnerships with Lyft and COTA to provide students with discounted or free transportation around Central

31 WHEREAS, The Ohio State University has already established transportation networks including CABS and

34 34 35 WHEREAS, students who wish to return their absentee ballots in-person may use this free, safe, socially distant 36 transportation; and at The Ohio State University

38 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of Graduate Students officially recommends that The Ohio State

39 University fund and coordinate safe, socially distant, and free transportation from the campus area to the

40 Franklin County Board of Elections for students who wish to vote during early vote; and
