The Council of Graduate Students (CGS), in partnership with the Office of Outreach and Engagement, Office of Student Life, Office of Research, and Ohio State University Extension (OSUE) is pleased to announce the availability of the Engaged Scholar Grant.

The Engaged Scholar Grant incentivizes graduate and professional students to undertake community-engaged research or community-engaged projects, in collaboration with a community partner, that address a specific need or problem within the community (in-state or out-of-state). **Graduate and professional students may apply for grants ranging from \$500 to \$1,500.**

Grants may be used to support new and/or expand existing research and/or projects related to well-structured community-engaged initiatives. **All students are required to collaborate with a community partner for their proposal and research/project.** Students conducting research/projects within the state of Ohio will be connected with Ohio State University Extension to potentially collaborate with the County Extension Office on their research/project. Upon being awarded the grant CGS will connect students with appropriate Extension officials. However, students are encouraged to connect with their local Extension Office prior to submitting their grant application.

Students expected graduation date must be **on or after** the summer one calendar year after the application deadline.
